Manager Belmore stated that the City was continuing negotiations with various unions that City staff belong to.

Councilor Dumont asked about the number of total firefighter positions open that was reported in the newspaper. Belmore stated that they hired a new firefighter today and the City is looking for 1 more full-time position open and the department was looking for on-call firefighters. Belmore also reported that there is new police K-9 in training. The committee discussed the SAU 56 withdrawal and what the committee and Council role would be in the discussion.

Cameron moved to go into nonpublic to discuss personnel per RSA 91-A at 5:01pm, seconded by Levasseur, the motion passed unanimously by roll call. and the meeting entered nonpublic and the public session adjourned.
