Collection Program Guidelines

For 2022 all trash and recycling services will remain the same and your collection days will not change. Recycling will continue to be picked up every other week on either a Green or Blue week as shown in the 2022 Collection Schedule on the back side of this brochure. Please check the City website to determine if your recycling will be collected on a Green or Blue week - www.somersworth.com/residents/trash and recycling must be at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. and no sooner than the evening before your designated collection day.

- All trash must be contained in authorized City of Somersworth bags to be collected.
- All recyclable items can be placed in one container - no sorting required - for easy curbside collection.
- Residents can use any rigid plastic container up to 35 gallon in size and clearly marked Recyclables.

City of Somersworth Public Works Brush Collection Days

Scheduled Brush must be curbside by Monday at 7:00 a.m. Please call Public Works at (603) 692-4266 by 3 p.m. the Friday before to be added to the collection schedule. Please note: brush can be up to five (5) inches in diameter and ten (10) feet long. Only scheduled services will be collected.

Brush weeks – **April 18 - 22, May 16 - 20, October 17 - 21, November 14 - 18.**

Bagged Leaves Collection

Residents do not need to call ahead for pickup. Bags must be curbside no sooner than the evening before and no later than 7:00 a.m. on your trash pickup day. Leaves and grass clippings must be in brown paper leaf bags, sold at many local stores.

Bagged Leaves weeks **April 25- 29, May 23-27, October 24 -2 8, November 21 - 26.**

Household Hazardous Waste

Household Hazardous Waste Collection day for the City of Somersworth will be at the Turnkey Landfill in Rochester on **Saturday, May 7, 2022** from 8:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. Residents must bring a photo ID with proof of residency. You may also visit www.thinkgreenfromhome.com, Waste Management’s site dedicated to household solutions for household hazardous waste and medical sharps. More information can be found at the City’s website and on Cable Television Channel 22. The following items will NOT be collected by Waste Management from any residences or businesses. Metal & Electronic Waste

Metal and electronic waste are collected the second Tuesday of each month. Please call City of Somersworth Public Works at (603) 692-4266 by 3 p.m. the Monday before to be added to the collection schedule.

Bulky Waste Charges

Bulky waste items must have a ‘bulky waste sticker’ affixed whether they are to be picked up curbside or dropped off at the Public Works Facility, in accordance with the metal/non-metal designations below. Stickers can be purchased at City Hall, the Somersworth Public Library during regular business hours or Stickers can also be purchased at the Public Works Facility (checks only). Stickers cost \$4.00 each and cover 50 lbs of waste. Items that contain refrigerant (air conditioners, refrigerators, etc.) will require a \$10.00 refrigerant sticker.

Listed below are examples of various items and the estimated cost to dispose of them. Each item is unique and the cost of disposal will depend on the weight of the item. One sticker is required for every 50 lbs. **Non-metal bulky waste items must be curbside by 7 a.m. on your trash pickup day**

Metal and Electronic Items are picked up curbside on the 2nd Tuesday of the month. Items must be curbside by 7:00 a.m. the day of pickup, Call the City of Somersworth Public Works (603) 692-4266 to be added to the scheduled pickup list. Only scheduled services will be collected. Metal can also be dropped off at public works*.
