Position Title: Camp Directors (40 hrs. Full-time)

Pay Range: \$16.00 Must be 18+

Qualifications: High School Diploma or GED required. Experience in coordinating, planning, and implementing activities for children in Kids Camp (grades 1-5). Interested individuals should have strong organizational and communication skills, be self-motivated, enthusiastic, and exercise leadership skills. Ability to maintain accurate and detailed records regarding participants’ attendance or any camper related issues. Ability to establish effective working relationships with parents, employees and the public. Knowledge in safety precautions and occupational hazards. Ability to work outdoors in summer heat. Supervision of Counselors to ensure program rules and policies are followed for the safety of all. Supervision of children on playgrounds, park grounds, field trips, and during various activities expected at all times. First Aid/CPR/AED certification desirable.

Duties/Responsibilities: Under the supervision of the Recreation Supervisor, Directors are responsible for providing leadership, supervision, and safety to children and staff at all times during the program day. Directors will plan and implement a full 8-week program for Kids Camp (kids in grades 1-5). Responsibilities include developing activities & games designed to keep children engaged and active. Position is responsible for ensuring that environments are safe and that all children are accounted for at all times. Director’s full attention should be placed on the children as you work to bring fun and security to their summer.

Position Title: Camp Counselors (40 hrs. Full-time and 20 to 24 hr. Part-time)

Pay Range: \$14.00 Must be 16+

Qualifications: Attending High School or received Diploma/GED required. Previous experience working with children. Interested individuals must enjoy working with children, be energetic, and enjoy working outdoors. Ability to establish effective working relationships with parents, employees, and the public. Knowledge of safety precautions and occupational hazards. Ability to work outdoors in summer heat. Supervision of children on playgrounds, park grounds, field trips, and during various activities expected at all times. First Aid/CPR/AED certification desirable.

Duties/Responsibilities: Under the supervision of the Recreation Supervisor and Camp Director(s), Counselors are responsible for providing supervision and safety to campers at all times during the camp day. Duties may include leading and/or assisting in supervision of various games & activities, arts & crafts, and special events for children in Kids Camp (grades 1-5). Counselor’s full attention should be placed on the children as you work to bring fun and security to their summer.
