- 50 Jumping jacks
- 25 Right side crunches
- 25 Left side crunches
- 50 Mountain climbers

- 30 Calf raises
- 10 Jumping squats
- 30 Second wall sit
- 30 Triceps Dips
- 25 Leg raises

- 30 Bicycle crunches
- 50 Arm circles
- 30 Russian twists
- 20 Line jumps
- 25 Triangle push-ups

Creative Fun Pool Noodle Horse Sticks

Materials:

- A pool swimming noodle (1 per horse– the skinnier ones work better)
- Rope or twine
- Felt
- Large googly eyes
- Pipe cleaner
- Scissors
- Low temperature glue gun & glue

Steps:

- Bend the top part of the pool noodle down
 & tie the twine or rope tightly around it.
 Leave a little bit of the twine/rope hanging on the sides so it looks like reins.
- Cut a 1 inch wide strip of felt along the entire length of the fabric/ felt piece. Cut the ends of the felt into points for the ears.
- Now cut a 4 inch wide strip along the entire length of the fabric/ felt piece. Fold this strip in half and cut waves around the edges to create your horse mane.
- Now slide the 1 inch strip of felt (with the points) between the
 part of the noodle that was folded over. Pull up each end firmly in
 place and glue them to make your ears. Hot glue your mane and
 googly eyes in place.

Craft Corner

Firework Salt Painting

Materials:

- Table salt
- Paper (black paper works great!)
- Watercolor paint
- White glue
- Cookie sheet

Steps:

- Place your paper flat on the cookie sheet. This will help keep the salt from making a mess.
- Draw out your firework design with the glue. Thicker lines will work better. You can use a pencil first if you want to plan out the design first.
- Sprinkle the salt over the glue before it dries. Apply generously and then shake off any excess in the cookie sheet
- Get your watercolors very wet & lightly paint the salt. You don't want to drag the paintbrush. Try to drop small paint droplets over the salt.
- Allow the glue and paint to dry completely.

Freeze Dance

Turn on your sprinkler and play your favorite tunes! Have your child dance around and when the music stops they should freeze in place.

Animal Walks

Get silly with your kids! Turn on your sprinkler and take turns calling out animals to imitate. Run through the sprinkler while you pretend to be the animals!

Get 1 large bucket and 1 bowl per child. Have your child stand under the sprinkler with the bowl on their head. Once the bowl is full they should dump it in the bucket. Repeat until the bucket is full!
