- Scarecrows were originally made to scare off crows and other birds that might ruin a farmer's crops.
- The first Scarecrows have been known to be around about 3,000 years ago!
- After awhile most crows become familiar with the scarecrows and farmers will try other things like hanging tins in trees and using noise guns to ward them off. Birds are also scared off because of the smell of humans that linger on the clothes used on scarecrows.
- The most famous scarecrow is the fictional character in *The Wizard of Oz* who is in search of a brain.
- Nowadays, scarecrows are usually just used as a symbol for fall and harvest instead of practical use.

## Craft Corner Candy Corn Scarecrow



### Materials:

- Glass bottle
- Plastic cup (yellow or use a yellow sharpie to color it)
- Brown and orange paper scraps
- Candy corn
- Buttons

1. Cut an orange triangle for the nose and brown strips for the mouth. Glue on button eyes, nose, and a paper stitched mouth.
2. Trim cup to fit top of jar. If you don't have a yellow cup you can use a clear cup and color it with a yellow sharpie. Cut slits on the bottom of the cup to look like a straw hat. Gently curl the edges. Add a brown paper band to the hat and you can add flowers if making a girl scarecrow.
3. Fill with candy corn. These scarecrows make a great teacher gift or party favor.
