Friday, March 15 · 11am


Join local musicians Gerry Corr and Pat Boyle for an hour of authentic Irish music! Light refreshments will be served.





Book Discussion Group: Tuesday, Mar. 19 • 5:30pm


Book Group is open to all local adults who love to read. Join us for a fun and lively discussion. Books vary each month in genre and theme to keep things HORSE interesting.
