Chairman Scott Orzechowski called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Motion to approve the Minutes of the previous meeting held on December 17th made by Doug Watson, seconded by Jennifer Soldati. Motion passed unanimously.

- Committee discussed looking into fuel consumption in City facilities. Mike will look into how accessible this data will be for the committee.
- Committee identified two topics for future discussion, i.e. water conservation and solid waste removal.

Agenda item for next meeting: Committee discussed having a sustainable "Tip of the Week" for posting on the City's website. Doug Watson passed out a document from which we could choose four topics for the next month.
